




SOCCER NET SELECTION



Net accessories such as backstays, net tie-down stakes, etc must be specified separately.

- Always anchor goals, at the rear of the goal, per the manufacturer's instructions. Unsecured goals can fall over, causing serious injury or death.
- Never allow children to move soccer goals.
 Goals must be moved by authorized and trained adults only.
- Net tie-down stakes must never be used to anchor a soccer goal.
- Always use extreme caution when moving goals, and allow adequate manpower to move goals of varied sizes and weights.

- When not in use, chain and padlock goals to each other faceto-face, or to fence posts or other sturdy structures, to prevent tipping.
- Use movable soccer goals only on level (flat) playing surfaces.
- Never climb or hang on the net or goal framework.
- Remove nets when goals are not in use.
- Check all components and connecting hardware for structural integrity before every use.
 Replace damaged or missing parts and fasteners immediately.

- Always instruct players of safe behavior, and potential dangers associated with and around movable soccer goals.
- Ensure that safety/warning labels are clearly visible on goals at all times.
- If goals are repainted, contact
 Porter Athletic, Inc. for replacement labels.
- Fully disassemble goals for seasonal storage.
